

TEACHERS:

This is a new requirement added after identifying the need to verify that students are properly enrolled in events based on their course of study and language proficiency. Similar to what has been required of students taking the scholarship exam, this will allow Directors to verify when questions or concerns are expressed by judges, students and/or teachers. (All situations that have occurred in past years.)

There are two formats that you can choose from: a PDF version that can be printed and filled out by hand or an autofill version that will allow you to input the information before printing.

The document does require the signature of a campus or district official (ex. counselor or registrar) who can attest to the correctness of the document. If you have different counselors for each grade level, you should have each counselor check the veracity for their students only before passing it to the lead counselor or registrar. Principal signature is optional, provided for those of you who would like your principal looped into the process in case of the possibility of a situation arising.

THIS DOCUMENT NEEDS TO BE COMPLETED AND BROUGHT WITH YOU ON THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION. There will be a folder provided for turning in this document and your students' media release forms.

We do regret adding to your pre-competition prep, but feel obliged to take steps to make sure that all students competing are eligible to compete and correctly placed. Thanks for your understanding.
